During January-March 2024, the following significant programmes/activities were conducted by MDP Division.

• 11-Months Post Graduate Certificate Programme in International Business & Finance (Batch-6) – Hybrid (24 July 2023 – June 2024)

MDP Division organized an inauguration ceremony for the 11-Month Post Graduate Certificate Programme in International Business & Finance. The programme welcomed participants from diverse sectors, including government organizations, corporate industries, and entrepreneurial ventures, promising a dynamic learning environment.

The 11-Month Post Graduate Certificate Programme in International Business & Finance aims at providing transformative experience and equipping participants with the knowledge and skills to excel in the ever-evolving world of Global Business and Finance.

 4 Months Certificate Programme in Export and Import Management (Batch-21) – Hybrid (29 Jan. – 29 May 2024)

The programme objective is to build knowledge on the key aspects of Export Import Management, know-how on International Business, Market and Buyer Identification as per the post-COVID shifts of consumer behaviour, changing stringency of import regulations, new foreign trade policy, changing domestic regulatory framework on farm bills and its impact on exports, and tools for enhancing price competitiveness towards surviving in business in light of limited and reduced global demand. In all, there are 54 participants from
